

Besides the legendary Fr. Wilzbacher, there were so many other

memorable teachers: R.L. Sharma for his counter intuitive views, Panditji, simply out of place but always held his own; Mr. Jain, our math teacher and his stories about Chicago. And then there were the lower grade teachers: the diminutive Miss Francis, ssay Ms. Samrat, Ms. Lobo, Barar, Malviya, and George (some of whom later become objects of our early teenage crushes).

Last but certainly not the least were the students. In my later years, in other such congregations I have never seen a group of boys who were so talented, witty and intelligent. Always ready for fun, a good challenge and success. I wonder if some of their excellence rubbed on the little boy who came with his mother and joined the school in 1957.


sports and the rapid fire, along with some questions thrown out to the audience as well - the correct answers to which earned them chocolates!


Second match: Golds defeated Blues by 4 wickets to enter finals. Blues

Though recognized as an exceptional pilot, his MIG 21 crashed while patrolling near the Indian North-East border and we lost a brave soldier at the young age of 24. He was awarded with VISHISHTHA SEWA PADAK after martyrdom for his Exceptional

Services & Military Intelligence". Manyu was a born athelete and he excelled in his favourite sport of Football playing at the National level for school and college. During his NDA tenure, he played a vital role in defeating France Defence Academy Team and was awarded as "Most Energetic Player" by the Admiral of France Defence Academy.

The commerative friendly match was played between Xavier's Alumni and Xavier's School Football Team at School grounds. Both the teams showcased excellent team spirit with an energetic display of footwork and strategy. 
