ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING DECEMBER, 2024

The Annual General Meeting of the Alumni was a momentous occasion and was very well attended. The meeting was presided over by Rev. Father Dominic, Rev Father Nelson, Rev. On the occasion, members of the Executive Committee of St. Xaviers Alumni and the Xaviers Platinum Jubilee Committee were present along with other distinguished members of the Alumni, parents and teachers.

President of Xaviers Alumni, Mr. Luv Shekhawat presented the Annual report of 2024. He announced that the Platinum Jubilee celebrations were officially launched on December 24th and that 2025 marks the beginning of a milestone in Xaviers' history. He said "with the vision of Connect, Create, and Contribute, we formed the Platinum Jubilee Committee - tasked with uniting alumni across generations, fostering innovative initiatives, and giving back to our Alma Mater. "Alma Connect," a pioneering app that serves as an e-directory and interactive platform for all members, spanning from the Class of 1950 to the Class of 2024 was launched. 

MANU GARG – A JOURNEY FROM IMPAIRED SIGHT TO PERFECT VISION

Little did 8 years old Manu Garg know that his formative and fun filled journey of learning at the age of 8, when he joined St. Xavier's School, Jaipur in Class III, would come to an abrupt patch of sudden darkened blur at the age of 13.

When words on a printed page began to fade away and an unwanted shade of blackness crept silently during Class VIII, he was detected with a rare genetic macular disease - retinitis pigmentosa, leading to the degeneration of retina cells. And just as how it sounds complex merely to read it, the effect it had on the young scholastic were further unimaginable. He was now groping unsuccessfully to read his chapters, beginning to lose the company of friends, finding himself bottled in an isolated barrel of nothingness.

To save himself from the embarrassment of being unable to read in my English class, he memorized a couple of pages and pretended to read it fluently and confidently. Deep down he knew he was fighting a losing battle.

With limited options left, all that Manu had was to fall back on was himself and his family. His mother, a perfect example of selfless love and care had now become his eyes. She would spend hours of the day and night reading all the textual

material he needed to study for assignments and exams. At school, we printed question papers in a bigger font and got him a writer. Vandanaji, who often visited the school and met his teachers to share his concerns and seek help and blessings.

Manu still never showed signs of despair. Instead, he pushed himself beyond limits to keep abreast with school curriculum. His mighty 9.8 CGPA (93.1%) in 10th Board Exams not only reassured him of his capability but also geared him to believe in the fact - 'when the going gets tough, the tough get going'!

Considering his condition teachers had advised him not to select Informatics Practices (Computer Science), being a screen-based subject. He surprised everyone by securing 93.6% in the XII Board Exams, topping Informatics Practices with a perfect 100% score. He left the portals of Xavier's Jaipur in 2019 and graduated in History and Political Science from Hindu College, Delhi. With Covid-19 and its online lessons, it wasn't easy for Manu. Still he went on to acquire his Masters degree in Politics with specialization in International Relations from the School of International Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, Delhi. Later on, he pursued his research degree and completed his Ph.D. programme in Centre for South Asian



Studies, School of International Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, Delhi.

Among other competitive exams Manu qualified UGC net JRF in Political Science with a score of 99.1 percentile. He got top ranks in Common University Entrance Test PG (CUET PG), University of Rajasthan Admission Test PG (URAT PG) and Delhi University Entrance test PG (DUET PG). Manu also secured 4th rank in the centre for international legal studies Ph.D. viva and got 6th rank in Centre for Inner Asian Studies and Ph.d. viva in open categories.

He made himself, his family and Alma Mater proud on this day when he realized his dream. It was a day which had summarized all his challenges, efforts, sleepless nights of Vandana Ji, struggles to cope with the impairment and years of dedicated and focused grit and commitment. The next few days, Manu was flanked by journalists and media persons waiting to get a byte of his journey of success. All wanted to know the secret behind the great achievement.

However, Manu is mindful of his attributes and while giving full and deserving credit to his extremely sweet Mom, he says, "The unwavering support of my single parent, my mother and of course, the school that I studied in, XAVIER'S has emerged as a steel frame constantly acting as a support system during the foundational disability that crept in my formative years. I am proud to cherish a long-lasting friendship that believed in my innate capabilities."

When asked how does this moment feel to see that all his hard work has finally paid off, Manu humbly explains, "There is a feeling of accomplishment- exuberance for sure. The feeling of processing the gravity of the achievement is gradual and it also comes along with a sense of responsibility of contributing to a greater cause. Till now, the target was myself but now I must go beyond myself to paint a greater canvas."




The Batch of '94... bid goodbye next morning with hearts full of memories, a renewed sense of belonging and a promise to meet again soon.
