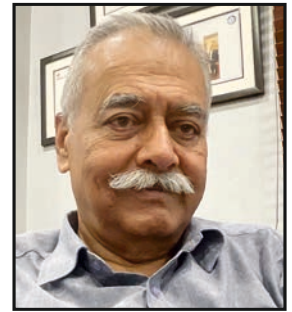

Reading this, my heart is heavy too. Piyush Pandey wasn't just an ad man. He gave Indian advertising its voice, its heartbeat, its Hindi, its humor, its heart. From a Xavierite of the 1972 Batch to the Executive Chairman of Ogilvy, he carried that same spirit everywhere — into **'Mile Sur Mera Tumhara'**, into **'Har Ghar Kuch Kehta Hai'**, into Fevicol's glue and Cadbury's joy.

He didn't just create advertisements. He made brands feel like family. He proved creativity with heart could move mountains. That **'Jaane Kya Dikh Jaye'** Rajasthan campaign is exactly the kind of work that etched our land on the global map — rooted, warm, and unforgettable.



Born in Jaipur in 1955, a former cricketer for Rajasthan who later became the man who taught a billion hearts to feel. PM Modi remembered him for his "creativity" and "monumental contribution to the world of advertising", and Gautam Adani called him "the voice that made India believe in its own story".

The Xavier's family has every right to be heartbroken and proud at the same time. A boy from those halls showed the world what relentless passion looks like. We will surely miss you Mr. Pandey!!! Rest in peace.
